Transportation Services:

1. The District provides free transportation to students with Individual Educational Plans (IEPs) through the Marin Pupil Transportation Authority (MPTA). In addition, low-income students are offered free Home-to-School Transportation. All students are provided the opportunity to participate in Home to School Transportation program.

2. Enter description of LEA's transportation services that would be accessible to pupils with disabilities, and homeless children and youth.

The district provides students with disabilities transportation through the Marin Pupil Transportation Agency (MPTA). The MPTA is a joint-powers agency that was formed by school districts in Marin county to meet the transportation needs of students with disabilities. The MPTA contracts with First Student that operates ambulatory and wheelchair/ambulatory routes. Alternate provides are used on occasion as needed or required. The MPTA is governed by a board that is composed of the Chief Business Official of each of the member district.

3. Enter description of how unduplicated pupils would be able to access available home-to-school transportation at no-cost to the pupils.

Unduplicated Pupils are encouraged to participate in district provided transportation. As the district provides transportation for all students, Unduplicated Pupils are included.

Consultations:

The Marin County Office of Education (MCOE) facilitated consultation with local transportation agencies on February 1, 2023, to consult on potential plans. Specifically, The Bay Area Air Quality Management District provided evidence of supports to fulfill its obligation to consult regarding the transportation plans (<https://www.baaqmd.gov/en/plans-and-climate/local-government-support>). In addition, MCOE facilitated consultation with the Transit Authority of Marin (<https://marintransit.org/schools>). The District likewise distributed a draft plan to staff, administration, School Site Council, and Local Control Accountability Plan (LCAP) stakeholder groups for discussion and feedback.
