Transportation Services:

1. Enter description of transportation services offered to pupils, and how the LEA will prioritize planned transportation services for pupils in transitional kindergarten, kindergarten, and any of grades 1 - 6 inclusive and pupils who are low income. The Plan may provide for the LEA to partner with a municipally owned transit system to provide services to middle and high school students. An LEA may provide no-cost transit passes to students.

The District provides transportation at no cost to students with an Individualized Education Program (IEP) through the Marin Pupil Transportation Agency and other specialized transportation providers, as required to ensure access to a free appropriate public education (FAPE). In addition, through its partnership with the Tiburon Peninsula Traffic Alliance, the District offers complimentary local transit bus passes to qualifying low-income students to promote equitable access to school.

2. Enter description of LEA's transportation services that would be accessible to pupils with disabilities, and homeless children and youth.

As noted in Section 1, the District provides transportation at no cost to students with Individualized Education Programs (IEPs) through the Marin Pupil Transportation Agency and other specialized transportation providers, as required by law. In addition, students experiencing homelessness are provided complimentary bus passes for local transit authorities to ensure uninterrupted access to their school of origin. 3. Enter description of how unduplicated pupils would be able to access available home-to-school transportation at no-cost to the pupils.

The District provides bus passes for local public transit at no cost to students identified as low-income, ensuring that unduplicated pupils have equitable access to available home-to-school transportation. Eligibility is determined through existing income verification processes (e.g., free and reduced-price meal qualification), and passes are distributed directly to qualifying families to remove transportation barriers to regular school attendance.

Consultations:

1. Enter description of the required plan consultation with classified staff, teachers, school administrators, regional local transit authorities, local air pollution control districts and air quality management districts, parents, pupils and other stakeholders.

The Marin County Office of Education (MCOE) facilitated consultation with local transportation agencies on February 1, 2023, to review and discuss potential transportation plans. As part of this process, the Bay Area Air Quality Management District provided documentation outlining available technical assistance and local government support resources to help meet consultation requirements. MCOE also coordinated consultation with the Transit Authority of Marin (Marin Transit) regarding school transportation services and available student transit programs.

In addition, the District distributed a draft transportation plan to staff, site administrators, the School Site Council, and Local Control and Accountability Plan (LCAP) stakeholder groups to solicit input and feedback prior to finalization.
